

PHED 3106 Clearance Protocol

All students participating in PHED placements must obtain and maintain specific credentials. Meeting the clearance protocol means that your documents have been **submitted and verified by the PHED Placement Office** prior to the deadline specified in your course outline.

Required Credentials - All students must supply evidence of the following:

- Vulnerable Sector Police Check
- Ontario Ministry of Labour Worker Health and Safety Awareness Certificate
- Accessible Customer Service Training
- Ontario Human Rights Training
- Orientation Meeting Date Booked with Placement Officer
- Verification of Concussion Education (Accepted: PHED 1037 Leadership, NCCP “Making Headway,” OPHEA module, or NU Athletics training)

Note: Clearance credentials are not shared directly with placement agencies. Instead, the PHED Placement Office will confirm a student’s eligibility based on the documentation submitted.

Medical Clearance

Some placement partners, especially in **healthcare, long-term care and education settings**, may still request documentation for **influenza or COVID-19 vaccinations**. Nipissing University does **not currently require proof of COVID-19 vaccination** to participate in in-person placements, however students are **strongly encouraged to remain up to date** with their vaccinations.

Additional Training Requirements

Some partner agencies may require **job-specific training** (e.g., WHMIS, Non-Violent Crisis Intervention Training). These requirements will be outlined by the agency and communicated by the PHED Placement Office. Any additional documentation must be submitted by the deadlines provided.

⚠ Be Advised: Students who do not meet the required clearance documentation will be **asked to withdraw from the course**.
